

MINUTES

Super Neighborhood 68 – January 8, 2026

5290 Griggs Rd, 6:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m., by President Adjei. who advised the minutes of September 6, 2025, should be corrected to show meeting date of September 11, 2025. This correction was amended and approved.

Each active civic association submitted names of one delegate and alternate who would vote during matters requiring voting and serve as a representative whenever the president was unable to attend SN68 meetings. Reports were given by each Civic Association: MacGregor Trails, Scott Terrace, South Union, LaSalette, MacGregor Palms-Terrace.

As one of the SN68 Alliance Delegates, Ms. T. Alexander gave a report of the recent Super Neighborhood Alliance meeting. In addition, information was shared regarding the Alliance tour of the new Alief Neighborhood Center and services provided. There was a discussion of a possible community center in the OST South Union area. VP Parker suggested researching this possibility in one of our area parks. Ms. Wagner offered to contact the Parks Board to have someone attend a SN68 meeting to address this possibility. P. Wagner provided information regarding the \$50M improvement project to MacGregor Park.

SN68 President made appointments of two vacant positions: E. Davis as Financial Secretary and Adilifu Sabur as Webmaster.

Zach Lashway, KPRC introduced his replacement, Rilwan Balogun, who will be monitoring SN68 January 2026, seminar and available for community news reporting. SN68 reported 74 guests had registered, there will be no registration day of event. Breakfast would include tacos, pastries, coffee, water, and juice.

Ms. Mayra Hypolite shared from the Office of County Attorney that C. Menefee was replaced by John Fanbonne. Scam prevention information was provided. Additional information was provided regarding TODD (Transfer on Death Deeds), and the need for annual home appraisal protests.
