

MINUTES

Super Neighborhood 68, September 11, 2025

6:00 p.m. 5290 Griggs Rd Houston, Texas

Meeting was called to order by interim President J. Brown at 6:00 p.m. The SN68 bylaws were approved in June 2025. The purpose of today's meeting was: 1) election of officers, presentations by guests and addressing citizens' concerns. Previous minutes approved.

Reports were given by Civic Associations: Scott Terrace, Southern Trails, LaSalette, MacGregor Palms-Terrace, MacGregor Trails.

Surveys were distributed during the August 19, meeting to address concerns of residents. Plans are to start with highest community concerns and then proceed with others. The President gave a summary of the results.

Representative from Centerpoint, District D, and Public Works gave brief presentations of services rendered. Centerpoint shared the upgrading of electric lines, and installing new electric poles as the reason for periodic residential power outages which would improve as upgrading was completed. The following numbers were given by presenters for additional questions 832 393-3202 and 832 395-3082.

Attendees were reminded after reporting to 311, and given a case number to contact District D for additional support. Concerns for Spur 5 and OST should be report to TxDot.

The interim President called for election of SN68 officers as required in the bylaws distributed at the August 19, meeting. Each candidate was asked to give a brief (two minutes) overview of qualifications for the nominated positions as follows: President, B. Adjei, Vice President, L. Parker, Corresponding Secretary, M. Fleets, Communication Secretary, M. Rahman, Treasurer, P. Jackson, Financial Secretary, J. Brown. **All nominees were approved.**

The interim President turned the gavel over to the newly elected SN68 President, B. Adjei, who thanked attendees for their selections and a job well done. SN68 President pledged to do her best to represent the entire SN68 area.

The President of South Union Civic Club asked if nominees elected for officers had to be financially active members of a Civic Club, the answer was "yes". This matter was settled when the newly elected Treasurer shared that financial obligations had been met.

J. Alexander, invited everyone to National Good Neighbor Day 25, scheduled for September 28, Zollie Scales Park, 3501 Corder Street from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. flyers were available.
