Meeting was called to order by SN68 President at 6:00 p.m. Previous Minutes were read and approved. Reports were given by Civic Association: LaSalette Place, MacGregor Trails, MacGregor Palms-Terrace, Scott Terrace, and Southern Trails.

Guest Speakers: Dominique King, with the Houston Housing Authority introduced Bernicia Place, a transit-oriented housing development located on OST/Scott. Rate base information was provided. Space will be available for small meetings there will be enhanced security based on crime. The facility will have 5700 square feet of retail space.

Mr. Desmine Allen, City of Houston Solid Waste, shared new plan for heavy trash pickup “on demand” this approach was postponed. Pickup was three weeks behind. Illegal dumping pickup is on a call-in basis. Regular trash pickup and recycle is on time. Plans are to pickup tree waste and junk waste together until further notice.
